Academic Scholarship – High School Students

ASUTR Academic Scholarships are awarded to recent (within one year) high school graduates who earn an ACT composite score of 23. The scholarship will cover 75% tuition up to 15 hours and may be awarded up to 4 semesters.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: August 15

Continuing Eligibility:

- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale.

Honors College Scholarship – High School and Transfer Students

ASUTR Honors College Scholarships are awarded to recent (within one year) high school graduates or transfer students who earn an ACT Composite score of 23 and are accepted into the Honors College (separate application process). The scholarship will cover 100% tuition and mandatory fees up to 18 hours and may be awarded up to 4 semesters (fall/spring only). Scholarship Deadline to Apply: August 15

Continuing Eligibility:

- Be enrolled in a program that leads to an associate degree.
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 on a 4.00 scale and meet all other requirements for continued Honors College Membership.

GED Scholarship – Graduating ASUTR Adult Education Center Students

ASUTR GED Scholarships are awarded to recent (within one year) graduates of the ASUTR Adult Education Center who are first-time students. The scholarship will cover 50% tuition up to 15 hours and may be awarded up to 2 semesters.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: Fall – August 15; Spring – January 5

Continuing Eligibility:

- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.
- Must successfully complete 27 hours per academic year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.

□ **GED + Plus Scholarship** – Graduating ASUTR Adult Education Center Students

ASUTR GED + Plus Scholarships are awarded to recent (within one year) ASUTR Adult Education Center General Education Degree (GED) graduates, whose composite GED score is 600 or above, and a first-time student. The scholarship will cover 75% tuition up to 15 hours and may be awarded up to 4 semesters.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: Fall – **August 15**; Spring – **January 5**

Continuing Eligibility:

- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a technical certificate or associate degree.
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours the first year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale.

□ **Foundation Scholarship** – Current and Returning Students

ASUTR Foundation Scholarships are awarded competitively to students who demonstrate financial need by completing a FAFSA. The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1000, which students may reapply for each semester.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: Fall – **May 2**; Spring – **November 25**

Eligibility:

- Student must submit an ASUTR scholarship application.
- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree and have a minimum of 12 hours college credit.
- Required minimum 500-word essay explaining your educational goals and economic needs.
- Maximum of 10 Foundation Scholarships available per semester.

□ **ASUTR Public Safety Scholarship**

Applicants must be a certified public safety officer (active or retired) i.e. Law Enforcement, Firefighter, EMT, all First Responders, and Arkansas Correctional Officers. The scholarship covers 100% tuition up to 8 hours per semester.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: **August 15**

Eligibility:

- Must complete an ASUTR scholarship application.
- Must provide a letter from supervisor verifying employment status.
- Must maintain a 2.00 GPA.
- Applies to all class types- in person, online, and hybrid.

□ **ASUTR Career Center State Completer Scholarship** – High School Students

ASUTR Career Center State Completer Scholarships are awarded to recent (within one year) high school graduates who received “State Completer” status by graduation as defined by the Arkansas Department of Career Education, and who are a first-time student. The scholarship will cover 50% tuition up to 15 hours and may be awarded up to 4 semesters.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: **August 15**

Continuing Eligibility:

- Submit a copy of your State Completer certificate with an ASUTR scholarship application.
- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a technical certificate or associate degree.
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.

□ **ASUTR Career Center SkillsUSA Scholarship** – High School Students

ASUTR Career Center **SkillsUSA** Scholarships are awarded to recent high school graduates (within one year), who received “State Completer” status by graduation as defined by the Arkansas Department of Career Education, and are first-time students. The student must submit the state completer certificate with this application. The scholarship will cover 100% tuition and may be awarded up to 4 semesters. **Gold** – up to 4 semesters, **Silver** – up to 2 semesters, **Bronze** – one semester.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: August 15 □ **Submit SkillsUSA State Completer Certificate**

Continuing Eligibility:

- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.

□ **Arkansas SkillsUSA State Officer Scholarship** – High School Students

Arkansas **SkillsUSA** State Officer Scholarships are awarded to recent high school graduates (within one year), who received “State Completer” and “State Officer” status by graduation as defined by the Arkansas Department of Career Education, and are first-time students. Students must submit both the state completer and state officer certificates with this application. The scholarship will cover 100% tuition and may be awarded up to 4 semesters.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: August 15 □ **Submit SkillsUSA State Officer Certificate and State Completer Certificate**

Continuing Eligibility:

- Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.

□ **ASUTR DEAL Summer Tuition Waiver**

ASUTR DEAL Scholarships are awarded to current Dual Enrollment Accelerated Learning (DEAL) students. The award will be disbursed for the summer term provided the student enrolls in at least 3 semester hours. The scholarship pays 50% tuition only up to 12 hours. The scholarship will not pay tuition for repeated courses. The scholarship is not applicable for the Nursing program. This scholarship is awarded for the summer term only.

Scholarship Deadline to Apply: Third Friday in May

Continuing Eligibility:

- Complete an ASUTR scholarship application.
