The scholarship may be awarded up to 4 semesters (fall/spring only). 	<p><b>*Eagle Academic Scholarship (\$3000 per year)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates or transfer students with an <b>ACT composite score of 23 or higher</b>. The \$1500 per semester may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>*Talon Academic Scholarship (\$2500 per year)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates or transfer students with an <b>ACT composite score of 21 or 22</b>. The \$1250 per semester may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>*Quill Academic Scholarship (\$1500 per year)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates or transfer students with an <b>ACT composite score of 19 or 20</b>. The \$750 per semester may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility for Eagle, Talon, and Quill Academic Scholarships:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year and a minimum of 30 hours the second year.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul> <p><i>*Automatically awarded once eligibility is confirmed – no application is required.</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>GED Scholarship (\$200 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are graduates of the ASUTR Adult Education Center who are first-time college students. The scholarship may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall &amp; Spring – One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must enroll in at least 6 hours per semester.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>GED + Plus Scholarship (\$300 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are graduates of the ASUTR Adult Education Center, whose composite GED score is 600 or above, and a first-time college student. The scholarship may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall &amp; Spring – One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must enroll in at least 6 hours per semester.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Foundation Scholarship (\$1000)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree and have a minimum of 12 hours. To apply, students must demonstrate financial need by completing a FAFSA, complete the scholarship application and submit a 500-word minimum essay explaining educational goals and economic needs.</p> <p>The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1000, which students may reapply for each semester.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall – June 1      Spring – December 1</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>ASUTR Public Safety Scholarship (\$800 per semester)</b></p> <p>Eligible students must be a certified public safety officer (active or retired, i.e. Law Enforcement, Firefighter, EMT, all First Responders, and Arkansas Correctional Officers). To apply, students must complete the scholarship application and provide a letter verifying employment status. Students must reapply each semester.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall, Spring, &amp; Summer – One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>ASUTR Nursing Excellence Scholarship (\$200 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students have earned both the Technical Certificate in Practical Nursing <b>AND</b> the Associate of Applied Science degree in Registered Nursing from ASU Three Rivers, and are enrolled in courses leading to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing at Arkansas State University Jonesboro. To apply, students must complete the scholarship application and enroll in qualified courses (repeated classes are not covered by this scholarship). The scholarship applies only to qualified courses and is available Fall, Spring, and Summer. Students must reapply each semester.</p> <p><i>By applying for this scholarship, I am authorizing a change of major to the Associate of Arts in General Education degree.</i></p> <p><b>Qualified Courses:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>College Algebra or Quantitative Literacy (choose one)</li> <li>General Chemistry I</li> <li>Introduction to Statistics</li> <li>Humanities Art, Music, or Theater (choose one)</li> <li>World Literature I or World Literature II (choose one)</li> <li>Introduction to Philosophy</li> <li>US History thru 1865, US History since 1865, or American National Government (choose one)</li> <li>Sociology</li> </ul> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must enroll in at least 6 hours per semester.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.25 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>ASUTR DEAL / Concurrent Education Scholarship (\$200 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates who earned 12 or more concurrent education hours through ASUTR DEAL or ASUTR Concurrent Classes, and a first-time college student. The scholarship may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall &amp; Spring –One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>ASUTR DEAL Summer Scholarship (\$200 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are current Dual Enrollment Accelerated Learning (DEAL) students and enrolled in at least 3 hours for the summer term. To apply, students must complete the scholarship application and submit it to the Concurrent Enrollment Program Coordinator, Tara Bratton, at <a href="mailto:tbratton@asutr.edu">tbratton@asutr.edu</a>. The scholarship will cover up to 4 courses. <i>The scholarship will not pay tuition for repeated courses, is not applicable for the Nursing program, and is awarded for the summer term only.</i></p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Third Friday in May</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>ASUTR Career Center State Completer Scholarship (\$200 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates who received “State Completer” status by graduation, as defined by the Arkansas Department of Career Education, and a first-time college student. To apply, students must submit a copy of the State Completer certificate with the completed scholarship application. The scholarship may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall &amp; Spring – One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a technical certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year (fall, spring, summer).</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>ASUTR Career Center SkillsUSA Scholarship (\$400 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates who earned a medal at state SkillsUSA competition and are a first-time college student. To apply, students must submit documentation of the medal along with the completed scholarship application. The scholarship may be awarded as follows:</p> <p><b>Gold</b> – up to 4 semesters, <b>Silver</b> – up to 2 semesters, <b>Bronze</b> – one semester.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall &amp; Spring – One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Arkansas SkillsUSA State Officer Scholarship (\$400 per course)</b></p> <p>Eligible students are recent (within one year) high school graduates who served as an Arkansas SkillsUSA State Officer and are a first-time college student. To apply, students must submit a copy of the state officer certificate with the completed application. The scholarship may be awarded up to 4 semesters.</p> <p><b>Deadline to Apply:</b> Fall &amp; Spring –One week prior to start of classes</p> <p><b>Continuing Eligibility:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.</li> <li>• Must successfully complete a minimum of 27 hours per academic year.</li> <li>• Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale.</li> </ul>
